
Instruction Manual PC938 Steel Strapping Tensioner





PC938 INSTRUCTIONS How to use a steel strapping tensioner



1. Threading Tensioner

- Wrap both ends of strapping around product.
- Sandwich strapping with the bottom strap facing towards you.
- Squeeze handle towards base and insert strapping under the
- Pull strapping as close to product as possible to reduce amount of tensioning that will be necessary.



2. Tensioning

- Move handle back and forth to begin tensioning.
- Continue back and forth motion until strapping has reached desired tension.



3. Placing the Seal

· Seal should be placed open side down on top of both pieces of strapping.

4. Sealing

- Close nose of sealer around seal.
- Crimp tightly around strapping.

5. Repositioning the Tightening **Handle**

If handle is in forward position you will need to push Handle Pawl forward and allow handle to fall to the base (this allows you to remove the tensioner when finished or to realign strapping during tensioning).




When finished, cut excess strapping with a steel strapping cutter.




MAINTENANCE


Tools do need to be cleaned and maintained periodically with a steel brush or dry compressed air. Lubricate all moving parts with light machine oil.








If the tensioner doesn't grip properly, the gap between both grip heads is probably too wide:





- Remove bottom gripper (A) lock pin (B)
- Using a flat screwdriver, screw the bottom gripper to desired distance to the top gripping wheel (C)
- Align the closest slot (D) with the two side holes (E) and reinstall bottom gripper lock pin
- Test the tool
